CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Bolton reported on the following items:

Greenhouse

The Greenhouse salad bar will reopen to diversify food on campus with healthy options and comfort classic meals on Sept. 18. The salad bar includes a variety of greens, salad fixings,

a cold bar of prepared items like pasta salads, freshly cut fruit, grain salads, a soup station, and a hot bar with comfort foods such as macaroni and cheese, chicken, and pasta.

Sambazon Acai Bowls

The conversion of the Sweet Spot candy store on Ackerman Union 1st floor to a licensed SAMBAZON Acai Bowls will be on Sept. 25.

New Shop-In-Shop

The UCLA Store launched new apparel and shop-in-shop concepts from lululemon, Columbia, Tommy Bahama, johnnie-O, and Hype and Vice.

SOUTH BAY & DOWNTOWN PRESENTATION

Mr. Adams presented on the UCLA property acquisitions and highlighted the next steps for ASUCLA. He provided images, descriptions, and a timeline for the South Bay and downtown Los Angeles locations. Additionally, Mr. Adams discussed how the acquisitions will expand access to UCLA resources and promote ASUCLA services to the surrounding communities.

EXTERIOR MEDITATION SPACE & SUMMER IN THE UNION PRESENTATION

Mr. Champawat presented the background history, overall process, and implementation of the Bruin Reflection Space located adjacent to Ackerman Union.
